

Legal Terms and Conditions for the GiroStudi Cash Prize Draw

1.- PURPOSE.

IPSOS IBERIA, S.A. (hereinafter, the "Organiser"), a Spanish company with Tax Identification Number (NIF) A28485258 and registered address at Avenida del Llano Castellano, 13, 28034 Madrid, acting as the awarded contractor, will conduct a promotion in the form of a prize draw (hereinafter, the "Draw") promoted by Dipsalut.

The purpose of these prizes is to express gratitude to participants from both the controlled and open samples of the GiroStudi cohort study for their time and involvement.

Participation in this Draw implies full acceptance of all clauses contained in these legal terms and conditions. Participation requires no payment and involves no increase in the price of goods or services.

2.- PRIZE DESCRIPTION.

In each wave, a maximum of one Loyalty Prize and one Participation Prize may be awarded. As a maximum of two waves per year are planned, the maximum annual number of prizes will be four:

- Two "Loyalty Prizes", for a net amount of €500 each, drawn among participants in the controlled sample of GiroStudi.
- Two "Participation Prizes", for a net amount of €500 each, drawn among participants in the open sample of GiroStudi.

The "Participation Prizes" will only be drawn in waves where more than 100 people from the open sample have participated. If this minimum threshold is not reached, the "Participation Prize" for that wave will not be awarded.

In accordance with Personal Income Tax (IRPF) regulations, these prizes are subject to withholding tax or tax payment on account. The awarded contractor (IPSOS) covers the IRPF payment on account via tax gross-up calculation (gross prize value: €617.28; 19% withholding: €117.28; net amount payable: €500.00). IPSOS will send the winner a withholding tax certificate so they can fulfill their tax obligations.

The prize is personal and non-transferable.

3.- TIME FRAME.

The draw for each wave will take place no later than one month after the data collection period for that wave closes. The Organiser reserves the right to suspend, postpone, cancel, or modify the date of the draw provided there is valid justification.

4.- GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE.

This promotion is aimed at active participants in the GiroStudi study residing in the province of Girona.

5.- ELIGIBILITY.

Individuals who are part of either of the two GiroStudi samples (controlled and open) may enter the Draw provided they strictly meet the following conditions:

- Have completed all questionnaires for the latest wave within the designated dates.
- Are not classified as participants with Low Response Quality (LRQ). Low response quality is identified when the system detects that: questionnaires were completed in less than the required minimum time; low response variance clearly indicates a lack of attention; clear logical inconsistencies exist; or the majority of answers are left blank or marked "Don't know / Prefer not to answer". All suspected LRQ cases will be reviewed by a GiroStudi team member prior to exclusion.
- Have signed the mandatory Informed Consent forms (1, 2, 3, 4, and 5) required to participate in GiroStudi.
- Have signed Informed Consent 13 (authorisation to be contacted for engagement activities and prize draws).
- Have not withdrawn from the study.

Exclusion of previous winners: Individuals who won a prize in the immediately preceding wave will be excluded from participating in the current draw.

6.- DRAW PROCEDURE AND SELECTION OF WINNERS.

A list will be drawn up of all individuals meeting the eligibility criteria. This list will contain the project ID, full name, national ID (DNI/NIE), and variables confirming compliance with the participation criteria outlined above.

Each person will be assigned a unique identification number within a range from 1 to the total number of eligible participants on the list. For example, if the list contains 150 people, the assigned numbers will range from 1, 2, 3, 4, 5... up to 149 and 150.

The prize winner and alternate winners will be selected via a random draw procedure. The draw will take place at Dipsalut's headquarters using a manual random selection system. To ensure maximum transparency, a video recording will be made of the random selection of winning numbers assigned to qualifying participants.

The draw will be held in the presence of a representative from Dipsalut's legal department, a representative from the Dipsalut Observatory, and a representative from IPSOS.

One (1) winning number and two (2) alternate numbers will be randomly selected for each category (Loyalty and Participation). Alternates will replace the winner in strict order of selection in the event of renunciation, non-compliance with requirements, or inability to contact the winner within the specified timeframe.

7.- WINNER NOTIFICATION.

The outcome of the Draw will be communicated via telephone and/or email using the contact details provided by the participant. If the winner cannot be reached within 10 days of initial contact, the prize will be offered to the first alternate.

8.- PRIZE DELIVERY.

Formal prize handover will take place strictly in person at the Dipsalut offices (Parc Científic i Tecnològic de la UdG, Edifici Jaume Casademont, C/ Pic de Peguera, 15. La Creueta - 17003 - Girona). Digital or remote prize delivery is not permitted.

To process the bank transfer payment, the winner must provide a copy of their national ID (DNI/NIE) and a bank certificate confirming account ownership and IBAN on the day of the in-person handover.

9.- ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS.

Participants expressly agree to comply with each and every legal clause of this Draw. The Organiser reserves the right to make modifications to the draw mechanics provided they are justified and do not prejudice participants.

10.- PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING.

Data Controllers: The Autonomous Public Health Body of the Girona Provincial Council (Dipsalut) acts as Data Controller for managing participation in the Draw and communicating with winners. IPSOS IBERIA S.A. acts as Data Processor for the technical execution of the draw, and as Data Controller exclusively for managing prize payment and fulfilling tax obligations with the Spanish Tax Agency.

Purpose and legal basis: Managing Draw participation, verifying eligibility, notifying winners, in-person prize delivery, and fulfilling tax obligations. The legal basis is the performance of the agreement resulting from participation (Art. 6.1.b GDPR) and compliance with legal obligations (Art. 6.1.c GDPR).

Exercise of rights: Data subjects may exercise their rights of access, rectification, objection, erasure, data portability, and restriction of processing by contacting Dipsalut's Data Protection Officer at dpd@dipsalut.cat, or IPSOS's DPO at dpo.spain@ipsos.com (or by post addressed to IPSOS IBERIA S.A., Av. Llano Castellano, 13, 28034, Madrid). Data subjects also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Catalan Data Protection Authority (APDCAT) or the Spanish Data Protection Agency (AEPD).

11.- GENERAL PROVISIONS AND LIABILITY.

The Organiser disclaims all liability for damages of any kind that may arise from temporary unavailability or interruption in telecommunications networks. Furthermore, the Organiser is not liable for loss, delays, or circumstances attributable to third parties that may affect the development of the Draw.

This promotion is governed by current Spanish law.
